
Board Directors

At the current rate of change, it will take women 73 years to reach parity with men in the boardrooms of *Fortune* 500 companies.

UP: The percentage of powerful board committee chairs held by women--nominating/governance and compensation. *(Of note: Audit committees showed a two percentage-point*)
